Here are some important geometric terms.






Point

A point is an exact location in space. This is point *X*.


Line

A line is a straight path of points that goes on and on in both directions. This is line *AB*.

intersect.




Intersecting lines
Pass through the same point.




Perpendicular lines Lines that form right angles.


