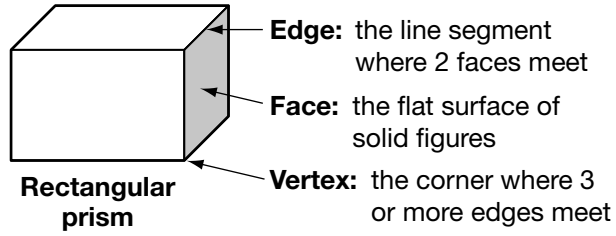
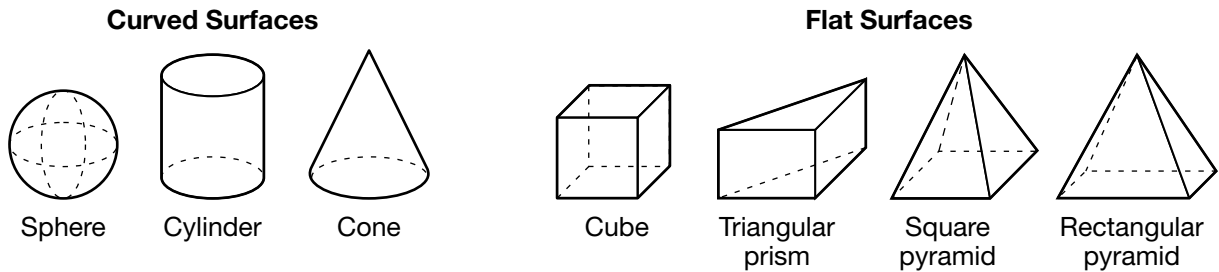


Solids
